May 26th, 2020 - grand juries on the other hand only serve to advise the prosecutor on whether or not enough probable cause exists in the case to indict a suspect and bring them to trial on criminal charges they do not determine guilt or innocence rather they simply determine whether or not the evidence against the suspect is significant enough to warrant a trial and potential conviction'
