May 27th, 2020 - tetanus vaccine also known as tetanus toxoid tt is an inactive vaccine used to prevent tetanus during childhood five doses are recommended with a sixth given during adolescence additional doses every ten years are recommended after three doses almost everyone is initially immune in those who are not up to date on their tetanus immunization a booster should be given within 48 hours'
